ABOUT

The **Indonesian Global Internship Program** is the Government of Indonesia scholarship scheme to fund Indonesian students for internships at top companies and organizations **overseas**.

Undergraduate and applied bachelor/vocational students could spend **one semester** at the overseas company and organization partners to practice what they have learned in a real world, gain a better understanding of industries, companies and careers, innovate and get creative in solving problems, and experience work culture in different countries.

The scheme is centrally managed by Directorate General of Higher Education (DGHE), Ministry of Education and Culture (MoECRT) and is open for undergraduate and vocational students from all Indonesian higher education institutions under MoECRT.

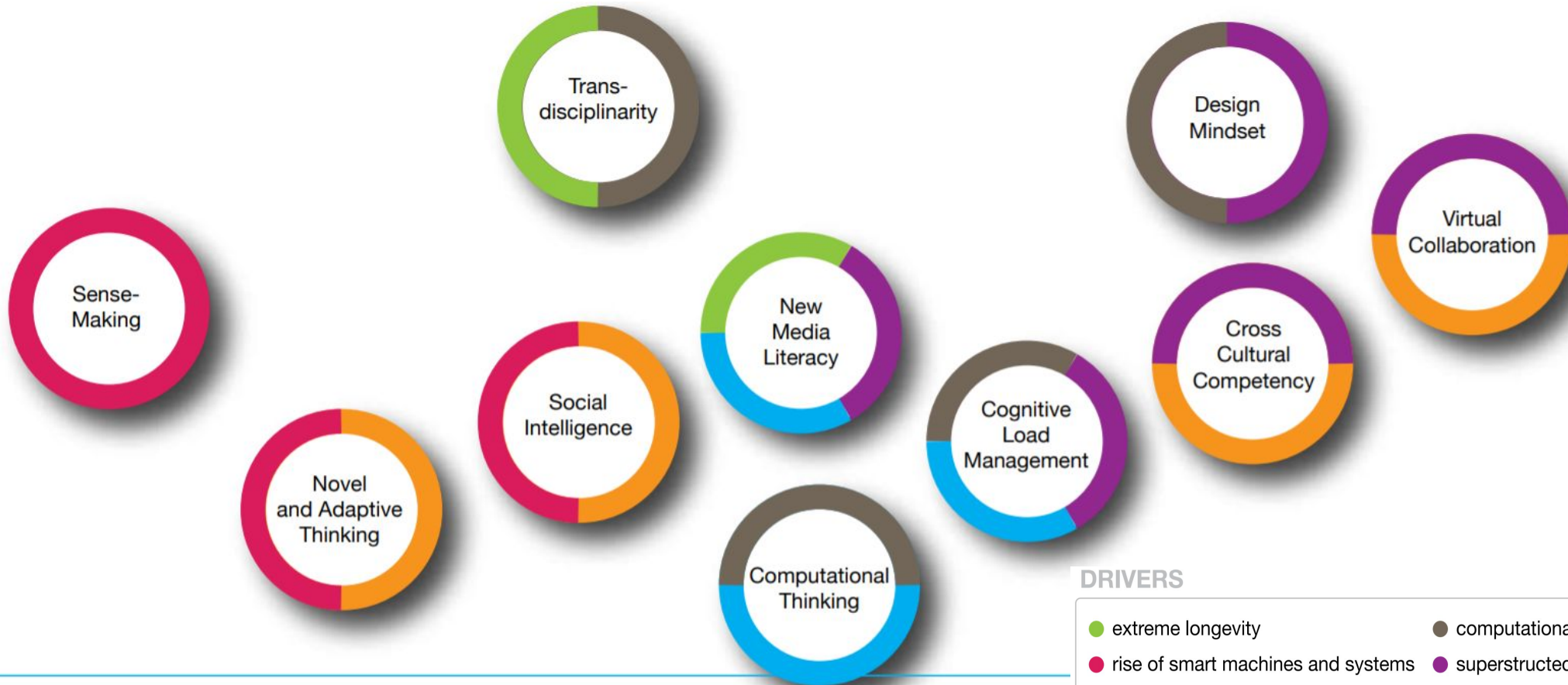

INTERNSHIP JOURNEY



1. Get to know the host company on the website

2. Find a letter of recommendation from the home university

3. Fill in the application form

4. Check the acceptance to the interview selection stage

5. Attend the selection interview as scheduled

6. Check the final announcement

7. Attend pre-departure series

8. Attend the judicial

9. Departure to host company

10. Fill in the logbook and carry out assignments

11. Return to the home university

12. Collect physical documents and get recognition of 20 credits from home university

ELIGIBILITY (STUDENTS)



To apply for Indonesian Global Internship Program, you must (be):

01

enrolled as an active Undergraduate Indonesian Student of recognized universities in Indonesia under the Directorate of Higher Education, Culture, Research, and Technology (DGHERT) or as an active vocational student under Directorate General of Vocational Education during the application and the program;

02

an Indonesian citizen (WNI) currently residing in Indonesia and do not have dual citizenship;

03

in the 4th- 6th semester (for Undergraduate/D4) and the 4th semester (for Diploma 3) when apply;

04

never have taken college leave during their undergraduate/vocational study;

05

have a minimum GPA 3.0 (out of 4.0) proven by the latest academic transcript;

06

have adequate English proficiency with a minimum score of IELTS – 6.5, TOEFL iBT – 79, Duolingo English Test – 115*

ELIGIBILITY (STUDENTS)



To apply for Indonesian Global Internship Program, you must (be):

07

nominated by the Vice Rector of Academic Affairs of your home university and obtain approval letter from the head of the study program;

08

not receive the living allowance from the other funding/scholarship from the Ministry of Education, Culture, Research, and Technology and Indonesian Endowment Fund (Lembaga Pengelola Dana Pendidikan – LPDP) during the IGIP Program;

09

not participating in other Kampus Merdeka programs at the same time as the Indonesian Global Internship Program;

10

not take courses at home University during the program

11

never have violated the rules, norms, and/or laws applied in Indonesia;

12

Agree to follow the rules and regulations while participating in Indonesian Global Internship Program

REQUIRED DOCUMENTS (STUDENTS)



To apply for Indonesian Global Internship Program, you must submit (have):

01

Recommendation letter signed by Head of Study Program on behalf of Vice Rector of Academic Affairs.

02

Valid English proficiency certificate IELTS (min score 6.5), TOEFL-iBT (min score 79), or Duolingo (min score 115).

03

Official Academic transcript (in English).

04

Clearance from Narcotic, Psychotropic, or other addictive substances from public health care or hospital

05

Police Clearance Certificate (SKCK)

06

Curriculum Vitae

07

Absolute Statement of Responsibility sign by parents/guardians and scholarship recipients

08

Video profile: 2-minute self-introduction describing applicant, skills, and motivation
